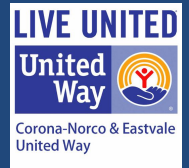

FAMILY SUPPORT SERVICES AT CORONA-NORCO UNITED WAY

Family Support Services focuses on providing crisis intervention, needs assessment, safety planning and psycho-education to adults and children who are victims of domestic violence. The program offers support to our clients in immediate or imminent danger of being hurt by an intimate partner or to children who are abused, neglected or have witnessed family violence.

The Family Support Services program is operated out of the Corona-Norco United Way offices in partnership with La Sierra University, City of Corona, CDBG Fund and individual donations like yours. The program launched in January, 2016.

Program Goals:

- To Address Client's Safety.
- Develop a Plan of Action for preventing recurring violence in the family.
- To provide victims with additional tools to obtain self-sufficiency.

Program Services:

Individuals in the program receive:

- **Case Management:** Work one-on-one with a case manager to assess the family's strengths, set and work on goals and connect to additional community resources.
- **Crisis Intervention:** Address the immediate safety of the client family in order to implement a Plan of Action intended to stabilize the threat of further violence with assistance of law enforcement agencies, Child Protective Services, the court system and other community service providers.
- **Needs Assessment:** Identifying other basic, mental health or social services the client needs such as emergency shelter, food, financial aid, legal advocacy such as filing Temporary Restraining Order(TRO). The Family Support Advocate prioritizes with the client to assist the family in getting these needs met.
- **Children Support Services:** School aged children and adolescents are offered 6 individual or family group psycho-education sessions (with siblings) to support them with processing feelings, learning to communicate effectively with others and develop positive self-esteem. *PARENTAL PERMISSION IS REQUIRED.*



Eligibility Requirements:

The FSS program serves families who:

- Live within the Corona-Norco United Way service area (Corona, Norco and Eastvale and surrounding unincorporated areas).
- Are in immediate or imminent danger.
